- Jacket Potato with Beans


We are working hard to try and get hot meals back on our menu – we are hopeful this could be in January 2021.

At Mass this Christmas, you will be allocated your seat(s) in advance and when you arrive, the stewards will escort you to the seat(s) assigned to you. These may not be the seats you would normally choose, but because the congregation could be much larger at Christmas and every socially distanced seat will be needed, every seat in church will be allotted in advance. You must sit in these seat(s) and not attempt to sit somewhere else. (We don't get any closer to the Lord by sitting in a different seat!).
