School Dinners

As most of you are aware now, all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal at lunchtime. Do you meet the criteria for Free School Meal status? It's important to fill in this application even though your child is getting a free school meal under the government scheme. By applying, you could raise an extra £1300 for our school from central government, to fund valuable support like teaching assistants, after school clubs and school trips. Food Bank

During our focus on Harvest, we are supporting Coventry Food Bank to help families who are less fortunate within our city and don't have enough food to eat. They have set our school a challenge for every child to bring in at least one item of food to donate on behalf of the food bank - items needed: Tinned Tomatoes, Tinned Fruit, Tinned Rice Pudding, Tinned Custard, Tinned Meat, Tinned Fish, UHT Milk, Sugar, Juice or diluting drink, Packet Rice/Pasta. Therefore, if you would like to donate to the cause, please send items into school and we will package them up over the next couple of weeks.

Hearing Screening for Reception Aged Children

If you have concerns about your child's hearing, you can book them in to one of our hearing screening clinics. The screening will be carried out by trained members of our school nursing team. If your child is identified as having a hearing problem, they will be referred to the City of Coventry Health Centre for a further hearing test.

Signs of a possible hearing problem can include:

- Inattentiveness or poor concentration
- · Not responding when their name is called
- Talking loudly and listening to the television at a high volume
- Difficulty pinpointing where a sound is coming from
- Mispronouncing words
- A change in their progress at school

If you're child has problems with any of these and you wish your child's hearing to be screened, then please contact your school nurse team.
