In response to the call to action from Pope Francis, 8 children from the Eco team attended the Eco conference at Corpus Christi School. We listened to talks about what Coventry is doing to help the environment from the Lord Mayor and Severn Trent. Each school then presented on what they were already doing to help the environment and their plans for the future. Our students spoke about the exciting projects they have started within school such as our wildflowers, vegetable garden and sunflower planting for Ukraine. We then spent the afternoon completing different activities such as making seed bombs, plastic bricks and experiencing the 4D room.

Assessments


