## Predicted Extreme Heat Weather Warnings

The Met Office has extended an amber extreme heat warning for Sunday 17 July, Monday 18 July and Tuesday 19 July, as temperatures will build this weekend and early next week for much of England and Wales. The amber warning highlights likely adverse health effects for the public, not just limited to those most vulnerable to extreme heat.

There is clear government guidance on looking after children and those in early years settings during heatwaves, including the use of ventilation, keeping children hydrated, and avoiding vigorous physical activity, encouraging children to wear loose, light coloured clothing and sunhats with wide brims, to use sunscreen, and providing them with plenty of water.

**NEXT WEEK – Monday and Tuesday (School is OPEN) – children will be able to wear their school PE t shirt/shorts/summer dresses to keep school. Children need to make sure they have water bottles, sun hats and are wearing sun cream. We will limit exposure outside on the playground to ensure that children do not burn or get too hot and bothered. Please remember that we have air conditioning in certain areas in school and will be moving children to these areas should we need to.**

## Food Hygiene Rating

Congratulations to James and his team in our school kitchen. Last week we received an unannounced visit from the food hygiene inspectors, and they received the highest grading – Level 5. What an achievement - we are super proud of them all. We are so lucky to have such a dedicated team producing healthy and tasty meals for our children. Well done ☺

## Pupil Progress Report

There will be a written Pupil Progress report sent home for Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 on **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July**, with an optional drop-in session after school **on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 3.15pm – 4:00pm** to speak to the class teacher about the report.

## End of Year Data/Attendance

On the same day, (Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July), we will be sending home your children's end of year data, detailing if your child is working at the expected level, at a greater depth or working toward the expected level. Children in Year 6 will also be bringing home their SATs results. Children in Year 1 and Year 2 will bring home their results from their phonics tests. Children in Year 4 will bring home their Multiplication Check results. These results will be carried forward into the next year group, ready for September 2022.
